Jane Armour worked with Beginning through Dressage groups in the early morning. She stressed awareness while riding in a school and effectively riding all four corners of a circle. She particularly noted riding a proper 20 meter circle is just as important to Dressage and Western riders as riding a balanced corner to and from a fence is to Hunters & Jumpers.

Next up was our Stage 1 Adult & Jr. BHS mock testing. Candidates were tested on progressives 1-6 for riding, theory and stable management. The riders will follow up with Islay Auty in November.
